SOUNDBITES

1. Ban_on_Holdouts

SOUNDBITE (English), Ban Ki-moon, United Nations Secretary-General, “We have been waiting 15 years and it is in a sense irresponsible for the international community just to wait. I urge again all those so-called hold-out States, eight hold-out States, to sign and ratify as early as possible.”

2. Ban_on_North_Korea_Fukushima

SOUNDBITE (English), Ban Ki-moon, United Nations Secretary-General, “The CTBT has been quite effective in terms of monitoring and verification. They have detected all of these explosions of North Korean nuclear testing twice, and they have effectively detected and gave early warning to Fukushima at the time of the tsunami in Japan.”

3. Ban_without_fear

SOUNDBITE (English), Ban Ki-moon, United Nations Secretary-General, “Let us work together with wholehearted commitment to make this world free of nuclear testing, nuclear weapons - so that everybody can live in peace and security without any fear of nuclear explosions.”

4. Bildt_Closeddoor

SOUNDBITE (English), Carl Bildt, Swedish Foreign Minister, “But to close the door on nuclear testing once and for all, and to guarantee this norm, the Treaty of course must enter into force and move from the political process and the moral process it is today to a legal commitment and an obligation for all nations.”

5. Bildt_on_Middle_East.

SOUNDBITE (English), Carl Bildt, Swedish Foreign Minister, “Another important value of the CTBT is the potential to reinforce other security and arms control measures, such as the initiative to create a zone free of weapons of mass destruction in the Middle East.”

6. Toth_on_Achievements

SOUNDBITE (English), Tibor Tóth, CTBTO Executive Secretary, “We are proud of our achievements. The family of the CTBT Member States has grown to 182, 157 of which have ratified the Treaty. The network has grown, station by station. It was in 2000, when, for the first time, a CTBT monitoring station was certified. By now, we have nearly 285, four fifth of the system, and it is up and running around the globe, around the clock.”
