Tyler Marchant served as the Associate Artistic Director at the award-winning Off-Broadway Theatre Primary Stages in NYC from 2000-2006, where he directed productions, workshops, and readings of new plays. He was also the Director of the Dorothy Strelsin New American Writer's Group, where he worked with writers to develop new plays for the American theatre.

He recently directed the World Premiere of *Freud's Last Session* which ran Off-Broadway for nearly 800 performances and won "Best Play" by the Off-Broadway Theatre Alliance as well as garnering Marchant a Joe A. Callaway Outstanding Directing Nomination from the Society of Stage Directors and Choreographers. He continues to direct professionally as well as teach at the University of WI - Stevens Point.
