Item#	Bidders' Question	Answer
1	Scope of Work – Section 2 Point c c) Load balancer configuration of the web proxy service Our assumption is that we will prepare the IronPort/WSA so that it can be used by a load balancer. It is our understanding that the configuration of the CTBTO's load balancer itself will not be part of our scope. Please confirm.	
2	Scope of Work – Section 2 Point g g) Integration of the devices into the Commission's monitoring system Our assumption is that we will prepare the IronPort/WSA so that it can be used by a monitoring system. It is our understanding that the configuration of the CTBTO's monitoring system itself will not be part of our scope. Please confirm.	
3	Additional points:  Do you have a standardized document for the required risk management, or should this be developed and proposed by our project management team?	A thorough risk assessment plan shall be provided by the Contractor at the commencement of the Contract. Bidders are required to provide their acknowledgement to provide the risk assessment plan, as specified in the Terms of Reference, in the Technical Compliance Matrix. A summary of what the risk assessment plan will cover may be provided as part of the proposal submitted by Bidders.
